Seoul (B)

The **Blue House**, otherwise known as **Cheong Wa Dae**, is the residence of the South Korean president. It is an icon of South Korea, set against the back drop of **Bugaksan Mountain**.

Today, we have the chance to visit the Blue House before making our way to **Gyeongbokgung Palace**, originally built in 1395 as the main royal palace of the Joseon dynasty.

We then visit the famous **Amethyst Store** and later stroll through the heart of the city down the streets of **Isa-dong**, a historical entertainment district. Step back in time in **Bukchon Village** before jumping back to the present day to walk along the elevated sky garden of **Seoullo 7017**.
